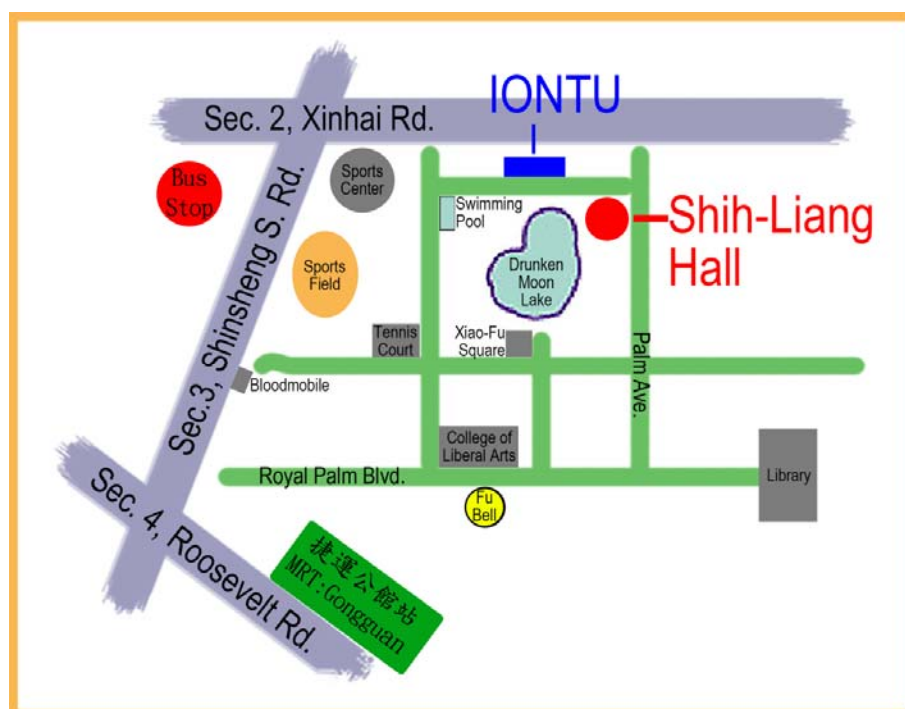
Guidelines for Presentations
